Magazines, journals, and newspapers available to senators and legislative staff

The Legislative Research Office Reference Library subscribes to a variety of magazines, journals, and newspapers covering a wide range of subject areas, including agriculture, aviation, business, child welfare, corrections, economics and finance, education, energy and public power, health and medicine, law, natural resources, Nebraska, politics and current affairs, science and technology, state and local government, and taxation.

All materials are available for use by senators as well as legislative and division staff. Copies of most publications can be routed to your office upon request. Those that cannot be routed are marked **Noncirculating** and are available for use in the LRO office.

The library also subscribes to **JSTOR**, an online research database focused on the social sciences that provides digital access to a wide range of academic journals and other materials. The link can be accessed on the Uninet by clicking the Legislative Research link under Divisions.

Periodicals by Title

American Affairs QUARTERLY

Each issue explores topics in domestic and foreign policy, as well as broader debates in economic theory, political thought, and social criticism.

The Atlantic 10 ISSUES / YEAR

Features groundbreaking articles on politics, social trends, education, literature, and the arts.

Aviation Week & Space Technology BIWEEKLY

The world's leading aviation and aerospace publication, delivering cutting-edge developments in technology, business, and operations in the civil, military, and space sectors.

Bloomberg Businessweek WEEKLY

Provides new and ongoing commentary about current business environments in the United States and around the globe. Previously known as *BusinessWeek*, the magazine debuted in New York City in 1929.

Child Welfare Journal BIMONTHLY

A scholarly, peer-reviewed journal that links the latest findings in child welfare and related research with information on best practices, program development, and timely public policy debates.

Chronicle of Higher Education 48 ISSUES / YEAR

A leading resource for in-depth information on U.S. colleges and universities. Reports on a broad range of academic topics, including government affairs, international news, scholarships, and athletics.

City Journal QUARTERLY

One of the nation's premier urban policy magazines, offering a mix of articles on topics ranging from school finance, policing strategies, and welfare policy to urban architecture and family policy. It also highlights the latest in urban policy theory.

Correctional Law Reporter BIMONTHLY

Summarizes the key legal decisions in corrections in a non-technical way. Issues covered include supervised release, probation, and parole.

Corrections Managers' Report BIMONTHLY

Written by corrections professionals, the publication offers practical guidance on how to effectively manage corrections facilities, finances, staff, and inmate populations.

Creighton Law Review QUARTERLY

Emphasizes legal issues impacting Nebraska and the Eighth Circuit. Includes legal articles, commentary, and case notes.

Criminology QUARTERLY

Focuses on examining crime and deviant behavior. As an interdisciplinary field, the journal features articles that contribute to the theoretical and research development of criminology and criminal justice.

Criminology and Public Policy QUARTERLY

Examines criminal justice policy and practice. The journal's primary goal is to enhance the use of research in shaping criminal justice policies by publishing empirically driven, policy-oriented articles.

The Economist BIWEEKLY

Provides insight and opinion on international news, politics, business, finance, science, and technology.

Education Week 40 ISSUES / YEAR

Offers articles, analysis, and opinion on key K–12 education issues such as education reform, accountability, assessment, and finance.

Farm Journal MONTHLY

The largest national U.S. farm magazine, emphasizing agricultural production, technology, and policy.

Forbes 8 ISSUES / YEAR

Features original articles on finance, industry, investing, marketing, and the law. Founded in 1917, *Forbes* was the only major business magazine in the U.S. through the 1920s.

Governing Magazine QUARTERLY

A nonpartisan media outlet covering policy, politics, public finance, and management for state and local government leaders across the United States.

Government Finance Review BIMONTHLY

Publishes articles on a broad range of thought and practice in state and local government, finance, and financial management. Explores best practices in government finance.

Government Technology MONTHLY

Covers information technology's role in state and local government. Offers in-depth coverage of IT case studies, emerging technologies, and the implications of digital technology on the politics and management of public sector organizations.

Harvard Business Review BIMONTHLY

Highlights research and case studies focused on leadership, organizational change, negotiation strategy, operations, marketing, finance, regulatory policy, and personnel management.

Hastings Center Report BIMONTHLY

Explores current ethical, legal, and social issues in medicine, health care, public health, and the life sciences.

Health Affairs MONTHLY

Examines current health policy issues of concern in both the U.S. and international spheres. Its mission is to serve as a high-level, nonpartisan forum to promote analysis and discussion on improving health and health care.

Issues in Science and Technology QUARTERLY

Published by the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine; it serves as a forum for discussion of public policy related to science, engineering, and medicine.

Journal of Education Finance QUARTERLY

Recognized as one of the leading journals in the field of funding public schools. Each issue brings original research and analysis on topics such as educational reform, adequacy and equality of public-school funding, and taxation.

Journal of State Taxation DIGITAL • WEEKLY

Provides guidance, information, and creative tax planning strategies for tackling problems involving state taxes. Presents comprehensive multistate information in both feature articles and multistate charts and tables.

Lincoln Journal Star DAILY **Noncirculating**

Daily newspaper covering the Lincoln metropolitan area and the state of Nebraska. Also includes national and international news.

Midlands Business Journal WEEKLY

Spotlights businesses in the greater Omaha, Lincoln, and Council Bluffs areas.

National Affairs QUARTERLY

Publishes thought-provoking essays on domestic policy issues ranging from economics and health care to education and welfare. Also covers legal debates of the day and enduring dilemmas of society and culture.

National Review BIWEEKLY

An editorial magazine focusing on news and commentary on political, social, and cultural affairs.

National Tax Journal QUARTERLY

Publishes peer-reviewed articles that include economic, theoretical, and empirical analyses of tax and expenditure issues with an emphasis on policy implications.

Nebraska Farmer MONTHLY

Offers timely information on agronomy, livestock, economics, management of production agriculture, and state and national legislation.

Nebraska History QUARTERLY

Explores Nebraska's history and culture through original articles and historical images. Features biographies and stories on political, economic, social, and ethnic issues, as well as institutional and architectural history.

Nebraska Law Review **QUARTERLY**

Publishes articles focused primarily on law in Nebraska and the Eighth Circuit, but also includes pieces on national and international law.

Nebraska Life **BIMONTHLY**

Highlights Nebraska's culture, heritage, and natural surroundings.

Nebraska Municipal Review **MONTHLY**

Features articles on laws and issues affecting local government. Of interest to municipal leaders and anyone with an interest in local government.

Nebraskaland Magazine **MONTHLY**

Spotlights hunting and fishing in Nebraska along with conservation, pioneer history, and in-state travel through articles and color photography.

New Republic **48 ISSUES / YEAR**

Features commentary on American politics, foreign policy, and the arts.

New Yorker **WEEKLY**

Features long-form journalism, fiction, and cultural criticism alongside coverage of politics, the arts, and contemporary life. Known for its in-depth reporting and signature cartoons.

Omaha World-Herald **DAILY** **Noncirculating**

Daily newspaper covering the Omaha–Council Bluffs metropolitan area and outstate Nebraska. Also includes national and international news features.

Pensions & Investments **BIWEEKLY**

Focuses on corporate and institutional investing. Features topics such as cash management, corporate finance, middle markets, and real estate.

Public Power **BIMONTHLY**

Directed toward officials of locally owned electric systems, this publication highlights innovative energy technologies and American Public Power Association activities.

Rural Electric Nebraskan **MONTHLY**

Geared toward rural Nebraskans, this magazine features general-interest articles such as how to reduce electricity bills.

Science News **BIWEEKLY**

Delivers short articles about new scientific and technical developments, typically gleaned from recent scientific and technical journals. Published since 1922 by the Society for Science and the Public.

Smithsonian **MONTHLY**

The official journal of the Smithsonian Institution, providing in-depth analysis of varied topics including science, history, art, popular culture, and innovation.

Stateline Midwest 11 ISSUES / YEAR

Keeps members of the Midwestern Legislative Conference up to date on policy issues impacting their states, actions being taken by the region's 11 state legislatures, and work being done by the Midwestern Legislative Conference and the Council of State Governments.

The Week WEEKLY

Brings together the most relevant and important news from over 200 media sources around the globe. In addition to original content, presents concise summaries of news stories and opinion columns — including from non-English media — published by other media outlets earlier in the week.

Time WEEKLY

Covers a range of national and international news, politics, arts, and culture.
